The first-grade insect unit has provided opportunities to discuss life Observation of the Monarch Butterfly has been great chance to watch metamorphosis, but there are a number of insects that go through a subtler change. Next week Mr. Cole's class will be taking a look at Milkweed Bugs Madagascar Hissing Cockroaches! Students will discuss habitat; provide food (vegetables), water, air, and space. The class will look at nymphs and observe the changes that occur as they mature. Molting, movement, mating, color and death are important patterns, developing an understanding of life cycle.
