Geometry -


Mr. Cole's first graders will study Geometry and Fractions sometime in December. They will be learning about solid figures like a cube and a cone, and about plane shapes such as a triangle and a square. Symmetry will also be a concept that students will explore, dividing shapes into two parts that are exactly the same size and shape.

Later in the month first graders will be introduced to fractions and talk about halves, thirds, and fourths. Most children will understand fractions in terms of "sharing" and cutting items into equal parts.
