## Solving Story Problems -

Math sessions after the break will focus on combining and separating within story problems, and then students will record their solution strategies. There will be three types of problems introduced. The problem types are as follows:

Problem \#1 - combining 4 amounts with unknown outcome. The pencil jar has 8 red pencils, 3 blue pencils, 2 green pencils, and 7 yellow pencils. How many are in the jar?

Problem \#2 - separating with unknown outcome.
Similar to above.
Problem \#3 - combining with unknown change. Mr. Cole cut out 8 big stars. Then he cut some little stars. Now he has 14 stars. How many little stars were cut?
